Licensing requirements – Medical marijuana-infused manufacturing license. In addition to the requirements set forth in the CMMC, the following requirements shall apply to the 15 issuance of any local license for medical marijuana-infused products manufacturing: 16 (a) Compliance with zoning; grandfathering of existing locations. A local license for medical 17 18 marijuana-infused products manufacturing may be issued for any zone lot where "food 19 preparation and sales," or "manufacturing, fabrication and assembly, general," or 20 "manufacturing, fabrication and assembly, heavy is permitted by the zoning code Denver 21 Zoning Code. Any zone lot where any person qualified as a "locally approved" medical 22 marijuana-infused product manufacturer as of July 1, 2010, in accordance with 23 subsection 24-411(c) and the CMMC may also qualify for licensing under this section 24 provided such manufacturing is considered a compliant or nonconforming use in that location under the zoning code. 25 26 (b) Sanitation, product labeling, and public health standards. Sanitary standards for medical 27 marijuana marijuana-infused products manufacturing shall be as provided by the CMMC 28 and any other applicable state laws and regulations. Any and all medical marijuana products 29 packaged by a licensed medical marijuana manufacturer shall be labeled in accordance 30 with state law.
