FOR AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN DESCRIBED PART OF WEST 29TH AVENUE, SUBJECT TO RESERVATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Manager of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity no longer require the portion of that certain street hereinafter described, and, subject to approval by ordinance, has vacated the same with the reservations hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Manager of Public Works in vacating the following described portion of a street in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, to-wit:

The South 20 Feet of West 29th Avenue adjoining Lots 4-14 inclusive, Block 6, Hoyt and Robinson's Addition to Denver;

reserving to the utility owners the continued use of and the right to maintain and operate existing telephone lines therein or thereon; be and the same is hereby approved and said portion of said street is hereby vacated and declared vacated subject to the reservations above set forth.

Section 2. The Council finds this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and public safety, and determines that it shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication.
