I reason for the request is so I can use the property for my business. Having the use of the property would make my business property look more organized and not so cluttered and would also make my business much more efficient allowing us to provide better customer service to our customers.

Rezoning Review Criteria

Currently, due to the growth of the business over the years, we have additional need for storage of automotive parts and customer vehicles. Also, due to the advancement of automotive technology, additional equipment has become necessary which also takes up valuable space. Over the years we have acquired various storage containers, trailers, etc. for storage and even that's not enough and so we have some parts being stored outside which gives the property a cluttered and unorganized appearance. With the additional space the map amendment would allow, we could get rid of all the small storage units and outside parts storage to create a much more attractive sight for neighbors and passerby's whether on foot or by vehicle.

We have also built a great reputation and long-standing relationships while supporting the members of our community since 1946. The needed space that would become available with the map amendment ensures us the space we need to thrive and continue to serve this community for years to come. The

members of this community appreciate our friendly service and quality repairs at a fair price and this helps them not have to leave their community when automotive repairs are needed.

The proposed official map amendment is consistent with the description of the applicable neighborhood context, and with the stated purpose and intent of the proposed Zone District.

My proposed map amendment would change 1453 N Wabash St to E-MS-3, which is Urban Edge. The property to the north (property I own) is on East Colfax Avenue, a major corridor, and is already E-MS-3 so making this amendment is a natural change as it brings the property in alignment with the surrounding properties up and down the East Colfax corridor. This amendment exactly and perfectly fits the general purpose and intent of this zone.
