



Department of Public Health & Environment Reentry from Jail Contract Executive Summary

The purpose of this contract is to establish and maintain a reentry from jail service provider contractor to meet the needs of people incarcerated in and exiting the Denver jails who are assessed to be at medium to high risk of reoffending. The Second Chance Center has been awarded the contract through a request for proposal by the Crime Prevention and Control Commission. The Second Chance center will provide services for medium to high risk people currently incarcerated in Denver's jails and once they exit back into the community.

Second Chance Center will provide services by employing the Transition from Jail to Community reentry model. Services will include mental health treatment, substance use treatment, employment services, housing services, basic needs, and harm reduction practices. These services will be administered with the goal of improving protective factors and to reduce the likelihood of recidivism.

Contract Description:

The contract has a duration beginning 1/1/21 and ending 12/31/21. The maximum contract amount will be **\$\$671,562**.
