**A BILL**

**For an ordinance authorizing the Mayor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Denver Fire Fighters Local 858 for the years 2016-2018, and to amend the current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That the Mayor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver be and are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed, in the name and on behalf of the City and County of Denver to make and enter into a written Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Fire Fighters – Local 858 for the years 2016-2018, in the words and figures contained in and set forth in that form of agreement filed in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, City Clerk’s Filing No. 2015-0213.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver be and are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed, in the name and on behalf of the City and County of Denver to make and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding amending the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Fire Fighters – Local 858 for the years 2013-2015, in the words and figures contained in and set forth in that form of agreement filed in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, City Clerk’s Filing No. 2012-0286-A.
