For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America, Federal Emergency Management Agency, concerning the "Incident Management Team Pilot FY11-12" program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Denver Revised Municipal Code (DRMC) Section 20-52, inasmuch as the Incident Management Team Pilot grant for fiscal year 2010, in combination with the Incident Management Team Pilot grant for fiscal year 2011, will exceed \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA No. 97.007, between the United States of America, Federal Emergency Management Agency, and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant Number EMD-2011-GR-1106, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 11-717, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The Mayor or his lawful successor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver, in its behalf, are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Grant Agreement and the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to attest and impress the official seal of the City and County of Denver on the Grant Agreement.

Section 3. The Mayor, his successor in office, or his duly authorized representatives, and other officials of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things required to be done in order to obtain payments under the Grant Agreement, including, but not limited to, filing requests for payments, contracting with persons and organizations in order to carry out the provisions of the Grant Agreement, filing reports and keeping records relating to fiscal and evaluation matters, and forwarding other materials to the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
