Denver International Airport (DEN) has selected Mile High Delivery Partners as the Program Management Team (PMT) to oversee the development of the North Terminal Expansion (NTE) Program. The NTE will expand and improve security screening, passenger check-in, baggage handling system, and Federal Inspection Services to accommodate terminal growth that will allow DEN to meet future passenger processing needs, while enhancing the passenger experience.

This Task Order Based Contract, not to exceed \$135,000,000, allows specific tasks or services to be outlined and issued as needed. Each task order will detail the scope, deliverables, timelines, and payment terms for the specific task.

The North Terminal Expansion project is essential to addressing the airport's long-term growth strategy under Operation 2045, which anticipates accommodating up to 120 million annual passengers and will provide the necessary capacity to support DEN's future growth

This project aligns with DEN's Vision 100 goal of Empowering Our People by cultivating a talented and diverse workforce dedicated to excellence and creating an inclusive environment. The PMT will provide program management support services, including community engagement and professional development initiatives. By engaging MWBE firms, the PMT aims to support their growth, promote diversity and inclusion in contracting, and enhance the diversity of DEN's supplier base.

By overseeing the development of the state-of-the-art North Terminal Expansion, this program also aligns with DEN's Growing Our Infrastructure Vision 100 goal. This effort aligns with DEN's goal to develop systems that ensure projects are realized efficiently and effectively to meet future demands, and to grow responsibly, ultimately aiming to become the most sustainable airport in the world.

Scope of work:

The Project Management Team (PMT) will serve as part of an integrated Program Delivery team within the Special Projects division to deliver the North Terminal Expansion program. The PMT will be instrumental in overseeing the development of the North Terminal Expansion project. This project involves the construction of expanded East and West sections of the North Terminal, encompassing the expansion of the ticketing facilities, security checkpoints, international baggage claim areas, Customs and Border Protection (CBP) processing, airline office spaces, and the associated building systems. It is designed to increase both terminal and Federal Inspection Services (FIS) capacity to accommodate projected passenger growth, establish connectivity to the planned East and West concourses, and incorporate extensive enabling work, including the relocation of existing utilities. The PMT's scope of work includes a wide range of services, encompassing program and project management oversight of environmental services, programmatic design and baseline development, permitting, and delivery method evaluation. The PMT will also assist with program oversight of cost and schedule management, risk management, quality assurance, and community engagement, governance, among other responsibilities.
