7 **A RESOLUTION**

9 **Extending the declaration of local disaster filed with the clerk and recorder to**  
10 **March 21, 2022.**  
11

12 **WHEREAS**, this emergency declaration is consistent with the Governor of Colorado’s  
13 COVID-19 Disaster Recovery Order (“D2021 122”), which focuses the State’s efforts on recovery  
14 from the COVID-19 pandemic;

15 **WHEREAS**, the threats posed by COVID-19, including the loss of life continue to require  
16 emergency action and resources to avert danger or damage and to protect public health;

17 **WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2020, Mayor Hancock filed with the CCD Clerk and Recorder, a  
18 State of Local Disaster Emergency Declaration (hereinafter “Declaration”);

19 **WHEREAS**, the period of Declaration is currently in effect until Monday, February 21, 2022;

20 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to state law, Colo. Rev. Stat. §24-33.5-709(1), the effect of the period  
21 of local disaster cannot exceed seven days except by or with the approval of City Council;

22 **WHEREAS**, out of an abundance of caution, City Council intends to further extend the  
23 current declaration until Monday, March 21, 2022;

24 **WHEREAS**, this emergency declaration is necessary for the City to continue to receive  
25 federal public assistance funds for emergency protective measures; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the emergency declaration gives the City the ability to expedite procurement for  
27 critical services that provide shelter for people in need and purchase protective equipment for  
28 Denver’s essential workers, among other time-sensitive needs.

30 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

31 **Section 1.** That the State of Local Disaster Emergency Declaration prepared by Mayor  
32 Michael B. Hancock and filed with the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver on  
33 March 12, 2020, be extended until March 21, 2022, and shall be in effect until terminated by the  
34 Mayor or by City Council in accordance with state and local laws.
