A BILL

**For an ordinance authorizing the purchase of capital equipment from the
Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund.**

WHEREAS, the annual Long Bill Ordinance 1539, series of 2024 authorized the purchase of six (6) dump trucks to support the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) operations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) is seeking approval to purchase six (6) replacement sweepers instead of the previously authorized dump trucks; and

WHEREAS, said purchase will be authorized from the Planned Fleet Fund (11804); and

WHEREAS, said vehicles are over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the purchase of said vehicles;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY
OF DENVER:**

Section 1. From the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11804, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
