Attach executive summary if more space needed:  The proposed ordinance approves the City's issuance of its Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Loretto Heights Family Apartments), Series 2025A and Taxable Series 2025B ("Bonds"). The ordinance also approves the City's utilization of the Private Activity Bond Volume Cap Allocation for the purpose of financing multifamily housing by Mercy Housing Mountain Plains and its affiliates located at 2980 S. Pancratia Street in Denver, Colorado. The Bonds will be a part of the financing package, allowing Mercy Housing Mountain Plains, or their affiliates, to construct a 100-unit family-oriented affordable housing community on the Loretto Heights campus. It is currently anticipated that approximately 15 of the units would be restricted for households that earn less than 30% of the Area Median Income, 8 of the units would be restricted for households that earn less than 50% of the Area Median Income, 44 of the units would be restricted for households that earn less than 60% of the Area Median Income, and 33 of the units would be restricted for households that earn less than 60% of the Area Median Income, and 33 of the units would be restricted for households that earn less than 60% of the Area Median Income, The State of Colorado's Department of Local Affairs has awarded sufficient Private Activity Bond Volume Cap Allocation to the City for this project.
