Background:This project is part of the "BUILDING A BETTER DENVER" Bond Program approved by voters in November 2007. The scope of this project includes the following:

- Demolish existing medians on Colfax from Galapago to Bannock and construct new, concrete, irrigated median planters with up-lit end monument structures.
- Remove asphalt intersections at Bannock and 14th Ave. and Bannock and Colfax Ave. and replace with concrete.
- Replace curb ramps, construct bulbouts and new curb ramps at Cherokee and 14th Ave.
- Extend bike lane on 14th Ave. from mid-block alley between Cherokee and Bannock to Acoma Plaza.
