The district was created in 2009 to contribute wards the initial improvements and maintain these improvements going forward. The project costs \$14 million. \$10 million is ming from the Better Denver Bond program and \$4 million is coming from the district. The bonds are being issued in 2010 and syments on the bonds will commence in 2011. The ordinance authorizes the sale of the district bonds, amends the 2010 budget to be bond transaction, establishes the maintenance and capital charges for 2011, and creates the 2011 budget. The work plan and diget is part of the annual responsibilities of a district and modifying the current year budget is typical when bonds are issued.
	 Please include the following: a. Duration: Construction of streetscape scheduled to commence in first quarter 2011 b. Location: 14th Street from Colfax to Market c. Affected Council District: District #8 – Carla Madison d. Benefits: A public/private partnership implementing an enhanced unified vision along the 14th Street corridor. e.
