A BILL

For an ordinance approving the execution of a series of Sewer Use and Drainage Permits from the City and County of Denver to provide sanitary sewer and/or wastewater services to property located outside City limits.

WHEREAS, the proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permits from the City and County of Denver to and for the benefit of the owner(s) of 933 and 935 South Sheridan Boulevard in the City of Lakewood, Jefferson County, cannot be executed by the proper officials of the City and County of Denver until after approval action or inaction by the Council of the City in accordance with Subsection 56-97(a)(4) of the Revised Municipal Code of the City, because the Sewer Use and Drainage Permits provide for the carriage of wastewater of a person or entity outside the geographical limited of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has duly reviewed the proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permits;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permits (a series of two) from the City and County of Denver for the property or properties collectively known as 933 and 935 South Sheridan Boulevard in the City of Lakewood, Jefferson County, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the forms of Sewer Use and Drainage Permits filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 20210086 is hereby approved.
