

Proclamation No. 10-0980

Recognizing Denver 8 TV on its First Place Awards for 2010 from the National Association of Telecommunication Officers and Advisors

Introduced by Councilmember Lehmann

WHEREAS, Denver 8 TV took First Place for its coverage of the Denver City Council meetings and First Place for Visual Arts for overall presentation in the 2010 Governmental Programming Awards video competition held each year by the National Association of Telecommunication Officers and Advisors; and

WHEREAS, Denver 8's video services continued its streak of winning second place for its animated public service announcement for the Denver Public Library's Summer Reading Program; and

WHEREAS, Denver 8 TV also finished in the top five nationally for short subject videos on Denver's Public Art Program and on Denver's Electronic Monitoring Program and for its Election Coverage during the 2009 election cycle; and

WHEREAS, through the years, Denver 8 TV has consistently won NATOA awards for its coverage of Denver City Council and programming designed to inform residents about City services; and,

WHEREAS, despite many changes in Denver 8 operations – significant budget reductions and changes in technology with robotic cameras and audio systems – the smaller staff continues to produce quality, award-winning programming with fewer resources, and the hard work, longer hours and dedication of the staff is worthy of commendation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Council hereby recognizes Denver 8 TV on its 2010 First Place Awards from the National Association of Telecommunication Officers and Advisors for its government programming and video production.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to Denver 8 TV.
