FIRST AMENDATORY AGREEMENT

This **FIRST AMENDATORY AGREEMENT** is made between the **CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER**, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado (the "City") and **BEAR COMMUNICATIONS, INC. d/b/a BEARCOM**, a California foreign corporation located at 4009 Distribution Dr Garland, Texas, 75041 (the "Contractor"), jointly ("the Parties").

RECITALS:

- **A.** The Parties entered into an Agreement dated November 14, 2023 (the "Agreement") to perform, and complete all of the services and produce all the deliverables set forth on Exhibit A, the Scope of Work, to the City's satisfaction.
- **B.** The Parties wish to amend the Agreement to increase the maximum contract amount, amend the scope of work, and insert paragraph 36 Compliance With Denver Wage Laws.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the Parties' mutual covenants and obligations, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Agreement entitled "<u>COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT</u>" Subsection 4.4.1. subsumed under the heading "<u>Maximum Contract Amount</u>" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

"d. Maximum Contract Amount:

- (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Agreement, the City's maximum payment obligation will not exceed **ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FOUR DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$1,165,904.00)** (the "Maximum Contract Amount"). The City is not obligated to execute an Agreement or any amendments for any further services, including any services performed by Contractor beyond that specifically described in **Exhibit A**. Any services performed beyond those in Exhibit A are performed at Contractor's risk and without authorization under the Agreement."
- 2. Section 36 entitled "<u>COMPLIANCE WITH DENVER WAGE LAWS</u>" is hereby inserted into the Agreement and states:
 - **"36.** <u>COMPLIANCE WITH DENVER WAGE LAWS</u>: To the extent applicable to the Contractor's provision of Services hereunder, the Contractor shall comply with, and agrees to be bound by, all rules, regulations, requirements,

conditions, and City determinations regarding the City's Minimum Wage and Civil Wage Theft Ordinances, Sections 58-1 through 58-26 D.R.M.C., including, but not limited to, the requirement that every covered worker shall be paid all earned wages under applicable state, federal, and city law in accordance with the foregoing D.R.M.C. Sections. By executing this Agreement, the Contractor expressly acknowledges that the Contractor is aware of the requirements of the City's Minimum Wage and Civil Wage Theft Ordinances and that any failure by the Contractor, or any other individual or entity acting subject to this Agreement, to strictly comply with the foregoing D.R.M.C. Sections shall result in the penalties and other remedies authorized therein."

- 3. **Exhibit A** is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with **Exhibit A-1 Scope of Work** and **A-1 Pricing**, attached and incorporated by reference herein. All references in the original Agreement to Exhibit A are changed to Exhibit A-1.
- 4. As herein amended, the Agreement is affirmed and ratified in each and every particular.
- 5. This Amendatory Agreement will not be effective or binding on the City until it has been fully executed by all required signatories of the City and County of Denver, and if required by Charter, approved by the City Council.

STATEMENT OF WORK and PRICING

A. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Contractor shall perform upfitting services of vehicles in support of the Denver Police Department (DPD) Fleet.

The City will provide the majority of the parts and components that are needed for the upfitting process, however, Contractor will be expected to supply some components to complete the upfitting process (e.g., screws, wire as necessary, bolts, etc.)

- a) The use of the word "component" or "components" refers to any and all items that pertain to the installation of materials.
- b) The City shall deliver vehicle(s) and the majority of components from the City's Fleet to Contractor, where the Contractor will proceed with all necessary upfits for each vehicle. Once completed, the Contractor will notify the City's designated contact of completion. The Contractor will allow the City's representative(s) to inspect the completed unit when requested. Upon upfit approval by the City, the City representative will pick-up the vehicle and the City may be invoiced. If not approved, City representative will identify the areas that need to be rectified and leave the vehicle for Contractor to address.
- c) No unnecessary (sound and unworn) parts shall be provided unless specifically ordered and/or requested by the City.

B. SPECIFIC INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS:

All wiring added by the Contractor must be PVC or crosslink style wire that matches to color being spliced to. Standards for the automotive industry include those created by the Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE), the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM), Underwriters Laboratories (UL), and the Recreational Vehicle Industry Association (RVIA). Contractor must follow these standards in upfitting these vehicles. All circuits that are spliced must be soldered and covered by heat shrink. All connections that terminate but are not connected must be covered by heat shrink. Any connection that ends in a ring terminal must be soldered with heat shrink or approved equal. Multi-link butt connectors or an approved equivalent. All hardware and fasteners must meet manufacturer minimum specifications or approved equal. Any changes, modifications or questions must be approved by the City representative before modifications may be accepted. Wiring diagrams, installation instructions and system component locations will be provided.

Contractor must have installers certified through a Sound-Off Signal and/or Whelen Engineering sponsored Blue-Print training program.

FULL DENVER POLICE MARKED BUILD/ DENVER SHERIFF MARKED BUILD

- a) Light bar and antenna(s) installation The lightbars, provided by the City, will be Sound-Off Signal or Whelen, for the up-fits. The lightbar will be mounted on the roof with the supplied hardware as per manufacturer instructions. Alignment for the light bar will be the centerline of the vehicle between the front and rear passenger doors. All light bar cables must be routed down the passenger side D-pillar to be clear of any side curtain airbag deployment zones. These cables shall terminate at the center of the rear cargo area with harness cut to length. Number and routing of radio and or GPS antennas is To Be Decided (TBD). Contractor will have clear instructions on antenna models, placement, and wire routing. Any wire harness that passes through the roof must be weather-proof.
- b) Wiring harness installation and programming A City-supplied, custom wire harness will be given to Contractor for each vehicle that requires upfitting (WAC-HRNSSTAHMAR) or equivalent. This harness will be routed down the driver's side, inside the factory harness channel in a way to not interfere with any factory vehicle equipment, sharp edges that will cause cuts or wire chafing to occur and be inaccessible to prisoners in the second-row seat (harness to be mounted under the prisoner transportation system). This harness will connect to the factory power and ground located in the driver side rear quarter panel (Tahoe PPV) and be wired as per the supplied instructions. Contractor will be supplied with DPD full marked Sound-Off Signal and Whelen programs to run emergency lighting and wiring system.
- c) Ecolock installation When necessary, install Intermotive Ecolock module part number A-ECL655-A as per instructions. This module is to be securely mounted in the void behind driver's side dash. The activation switch for this module will be placed to the immediate left of the steering column on the dash.
- d) Rear partition and prisoner seating system Install rear cargo partition as per manufacturers specifications. Protective film from plastic window will be removed. Install "outboard" seat belt system and prisoner seating system as per manufacturers' instructions. All radio brackets, antenna cable ends, central controller...etc. to be mounted on the left rear cargo side of the rear cargo partition (see provided installation manuals.)
- e) Prisoner partition/gun lock/side window cages Install prisoner cage as per manufacturers' instructions. Install supplied prisoner light on rear facing (prisoner side) top center of cage and wire to supplied harness. Install dual gun rack with AR-mount on drivers' side and shotgun on passenger side. Replace factory AR butt plate with supplied modification. Wire up electronic gun locks to supplied harness. Install rear passenger door prisoner window cages as per the manufacturer's instructions. Please make sure rear window switches are made inoperable. Rear windows must roll down with driver's window switch.
- f) **Center console** The center console stack will be organized from top to bottom: printer, lighting control, radio, filler plate and cup holder. The armrest will be mounted to the

rear driver's side of the console. The MDT side pole to be mounted on the passenger side as far forward as possible. The rear center console will have a microphone clip mounted for the P.A. microphone. The Police radio microphone clip will be mounted on the left side of the printer door. From left to right on the top of the console will be two aux power ports, factory USB and aux power port, two USB ports concluding with the prisoner light. The supplied flexible map light will be mounted in this area as well.
