The ordinance represents the City's approval for the expenditures necessary to execute the responsibilities of the district as well as the imposition of a mill levy necessary to generate sufficient revenue to pay the district's expenses.
 - a. Contract Control Number: None
 - b. Duration: Budget for 2011
 - **c.** Location: The district is located Southeast of downtown Denver. The BID boundaries are East 8th Avenue to East 9th Avenue from Colorado Boulevard east to Clermont Street and from East 9th Avenue to East 11th Avenue from Colorado Boulevard east to approximately Ash Street.
 - **d.** Affected Council District: Council District #5 & #10 Marcia Johnson; Jeanne Robb
 - e. Benefits: BID's are organized for the benefit of commercial properties to assist with infrastructure improvements and their maintenance. 9th Avenue BID responsibilities include marketing, community networking, installation of streetscape enhancements, and maintenance to promote business success.
 - **f.** Costs: The district has no outstanding debt, requires no mill levy but has the ability to certify a mill levy of 15 mills, and no active budget proposed for 2011. To date redevelopment activities remain on hold, should conditions change an amended operating plan and budget will be prepared. The district shall not incur any obligations until an intergovernmental agreement between the City and the District is approved by the City.
