Denver Workforce Development is adding \$75,000 in additional State American Rescue Plan Act, Reskilling, Upskilling, Next-skilling grant funding and extending the period of performance through April 30, 2025.

Scope of work: The intended use of Reskill, Upskill, New-Skill (RUN) funding is to provide assistance to unemployed or underemployed workers impacted by COVID-19 to build in-demand skills, connect workers and learners to quality jobs, and drive employer engagement in talent development with a variety of services. Servicios de la Raza provides and advocates for culturally responsive, essential human services, and opportunities. Servicios strives to build and cultivate a thriving Colorado Latinx community in which all members have the opportunities, and the support systems to achieve equity, self-sufficiency, and self-determination to lead a healthy holistic quality of life. With this funding, Servicios will enroll 300 individuals, assessing and addressing their individual needs, entering all 300 into trainings that result in credential attainment. 255 of those 300 participants will successfully complete training and with the additional workforce preparation services and supportive services, provided by Servicios, 275 individuals will enter into employment leading to self-sufficiency.
