### 5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

Contract ENVHL-201842363-01 for hazmat services expires July 16 of this year on reaching end of 5-year term. The City/Purchasing/DPHE is currently seeking new competitive bids for the same services, but we will not have new contracts in place for ~3 to 5 months. Meanwhile the City must have, without a gap, the essential hazmat management services this contractor can provide. This amendment will provide for a mutually agreed-upon 180-day extension of the existing contract, to bridge the time gap the City could be without essential services. This amendment would make no changes in other terms or costs, and would expire on January 12, 2024 or may be closed sooner as the City enters new contracts with new vendors for the same services. This contract and the scope of services is completely unrelated to services the city receives to support encampment clean-ups.
