This grant action awards supplemental funds for the cost-of-living adjustment increase for the Head Start and Early Head Start programs for Fiscal Year 2016.

Head Start population: 1,153 children.

Designated Head Start service area: The service area extends east to the City limits; south to the city limits excluding NW Denver from 52nd Ave. on

the north to Alameda Ave. on the South; west to Sheridan Blvd as far south and west as the Ft. Logan and

Marsten neighborhoods; and north to the city limits, excluding the Globeville, Elyria and Swansea

neighborhoods which border 40th Ave. on the south.

Approved program options: Center-based, Combination Program, Home-based.
