Executive Summary

Background

In 2006 City Council passed Ordinance No. 760, which enabled the Minority Women and Business Enterprise (MWBE) and Small Business Enterprise (SBE) programs. Ordinance No. 760 authorizes specific activities the Division of Small Business Opportunity may perform to prevent discrimination, provide small business outreach and small business development services in the areas of construction, reconstruction and remodeling, and professional design and construction services. The enabling ordinance will expire on January 1, 2014. The City has determined that the conditions originally justifying the enactment of the MBE/WBE and SBE programs still exist and that it is in the best interests of the City to extend the ordinance.

A 6 month extension of the ordinance was passed on May 6, 2013 to allow time to analyze task force recommendations resulting from the recent disparity study, and conduct an administrative review to identify potential adjustment(s) to the existing programs. It is necessary to extend the ordinance sunset date by an additional 3 months to complete the administrative review and draft new ordinance language for the Minority Women and Business Enterprise (MWBE) and Small Business Enterprise (SBE) programs.

Proposed Amendment Language

SECTION 1. That Subsection (b) of Section 28-83, D.R.M.C. will be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

Sec. 28-83. Review and sunset.

(b) This division 3 will be repealed effective January, 2014 April1, 2014.
