

Denver Parks and Recreation On-Call Material Placement Fact Sheet

Parks and Recreation Park Operations is seeking to extend the time and dollar amount for an on-call contractor.

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

This contract provides services to Denver Parks and Recreation for on-call material placement in Denver parks. The two main sites for work are playgrounds and medians. Materials to be placed may include mulch, landscape rock, cobblesand, gravel, breeze, soil, and playground material such as engineered wood fibar.

The two main sites for work are playgrounds and medians but may also include other park spaces, gardens, parkways, etc. Materials to be placed may include mulch, landscape rock, cobblesand, gravel, breeze, soil, and playground material such as engineered wood fibar. Fibar is to be refilled at DPR playgrounds at least once per year. Many locations require a refill twice per year depending on use. Playgrounds are typically refilled with fibar in the spring and refreshed in the fall if needed. Median material placement will happen throughout the year on an as-needed basis.

Procurement:

Three (3) companies submitted proposals which were reviewed and scored. Two (2) companies were awarded contracts (Bedrock, LLC and Pioneer Landscape Centers, Inc.) and began providing services in 2023. Since contract execution Pioneer Landscape Centers, Inc. notified Denver Parks and Recreation that they are no longer able to provide service and their contract was terminated in February 2025. Bedrock, LLC is now the only vendor providing these services.

Amendment Request:

This amendment request is to extend the time and dollar amount for our on-call material placement contract with Bedrock, LLC, as they are the only contractor providing product placement services.

These contracts do not commit funds, nor do they guarantee any amount to the firms. These contracts are not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via work orders on an as needed basis.
