8	For an ordinance designating 2070 Colorado Boulevard, the Dr. Margaret Long	
9 10	House, as a structure for preservation.	
11	WHEREAS, the Landmark Preservation Commission has transmitted to the Council a proposed	
12	designation of a structure for preservation; and	
13	WHEREAS, 2070 Colorado Boulevard meets the criteria for designation as a structure for	
14	preservation as set out in Section 30-3 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, as amended, by:	
15	(1) History.	
16	a) Having a direct and substantial association with a person or group of persons who had influence	
17	on society;	
18	2070 Colorado Boulevard was home to Margaret Long, a prominent figure in Denver's medical and	
19	literary history. Dr. Long graduated from Smith College and Johns Hopkins Medical School. She	
20	moved to Denver in 1905 to help cure her own tuberculosis. Beginning in 1909 she served on the	
21	staff of the Denver County Hospital. In 1914 she was co-founder and the first Medical Director of	
22	Sands House Sanatorium. She retired in the 1940s and devoted herself to researching and writing	
23	a series of award-winning books about Colorado's old trails and how they relate to current	
24	highways. Dr. Long was awarded the Colorado State Historical Society's first citation for	
25	distinguished historical service to the State of Colorado.	
26	(2) Architecture.	
27	a) Embodying distinguishing characteristics of an architectural style or type;	
28	2070 Colorado Boulevard is an exemplary example of the Dutch Colonial style. The building's	
29	steep gambrel roof, full width porches and oval windows in the gable ends are all character	
30	defining features of this style. The home has strong elements of the Classical Revival style in its	
31	two-story Doric columns and pilasters dominating the frond façade.	
32	(3) Geography	

- b) Having a prominent location or be an established, familiar and orienting visual feature of the 1 contemporary city; 2 The home built for Dr. Long is located prominently along the east side of Colorado Boulevard, 3 directly across from the Museum of Nature and Science and City Park. This building is a 4 recognizable and orienting feature of East Denver. 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF 6 **DENVER:** 7 **Section 1.** That certain property herein called The Dr. Margaret Long House at 2070 8 Colorado Boulevard, and legally described as follows, together with all improvements situated and 9 located thereon, be and the same is hereby designated as a structure for preservation: 10 Park Hill Block 32, Lots 5-7. 11 **Section 2.** The effect of this designation may enhance the value of the property and of the 12 structure, but may delay or require denial of building permits found unacceptable by the Landmark 13 14 Preservation Commission under the criteria contained in the Design Guidelines for Historic Structures and Districts and Section 30-6 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code. 15 **Section 3**.
