**CB10-0655 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed First Amendment to Agreement between the City and County of Denver and HSS Inc. f.k.a. Hospital Shared Services, Inc. d.b.a. HSS related to the Registered Traveler Program at Denver International Airport. (BUSINESS, WORKFORCE & SUSTAINABILITY)**

Approves a first amendment to the agreement with HSS to increase the percentage rental cost and to allow three additional locations for the Registered Traveler Program as part of the Total Queue Management System at Denver International Airport. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 8-5-10.

### **Finance**

**CB10-0609 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed First Amendatory Agreement to Institutional Network Maintenance And Collocation Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Mile High Cable Partners, L.P. (FINANCE)**

Amends the contract between the City and Comcast regarding the DIANE Network to extend the term through December 31, 2012 so that the contract is co-terminal with the Comcast franchise agreement. The contract specifies the maintenance dollar amount and gives the City authority to pay Comcast to maintain the fiber optic cabling. The amendment will extend the maintenance agreement to match the term of the franchise agreement. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-15-10.

**CB10-0725 A bill for an ordinance concerning the approval of Facilities Lease No. 2010A (Central Platte Campus Facilities) between the City and County of Denver, as lessor, and the Central Platte Campus Facilities Leasing Trust 2010, as lessee, for certain improvements to real property located at 1271 West Bayaud and annually renewable Lease Purchase Agreement No. 2010A (Central Platte Campus Facilities) between the Central Platte Campus Facilities Leasing Trust 2010, as lessor, and the City and County of Denver, as lessee, for such Facilities; authorizing the execution of such documents and related access easement and other agreements; authorizing officials of the City and County of Denver to take all action necessary to carry out the transactions contemplated hereby; ratifying action previously taken; making an appropriation for the Base Rentals due in 2010 under such Lease Purchase Agreement No. 2010A; providing other matters relating thereto; and providing the effective date thereof. (FINANCE)**

Authorizes the Manager of Finance to allow the City to sell into a Trust portions of the site and facilities at the Central Platte Campus located at 1271 W. Bayaud Ave.; to authorize the City to enter into a Lease Purchase Agreement for the site and constructed facilities; and to allow the Trustee on behalf of Central Platte Campus Facility Leasing Trust to execute and deliver not more than \$26,000,000 of Certificates of Participation proceeds (Central Platte Campus Facilities Project), Series 2010A. Proceeds from the COPs issuance will be used to reimburse Wastewater Management Division for the land purchase, construction payments, and costs related to the Central Platte Campus project. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 4-21-10.

### **Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure**

**CB10-0654 A bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between Reynolds, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for Montclair Storm Drainage Project, Phase 2. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)**

Approves a \$1,998,018 construction contract with Reynolds for Phase 2 of the Montclair Storm Drainage Project entailing construction of a 14-foot by 7-foot storm sewer along Jackson Street between E. 17th Ave. and Colfax. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 8-3-10.

**CB10-0671 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Purchase and Sale Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Housing Authority for the purchase of property at 10th & Osage. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)**

Approves sale of the City-owned parcel at 1099 Osage at an appraised price of \$897,225 to the Denver Housing Authority for 100 units of low-income senior housing as part of the 10th and Osage transit station development in Council District 9. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 8-10-10.

**CB10-0677 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory agreement between the Regents of the University of Colorado for and on behalf of the University of Colorado Denver and the City & County of Denver for on-call student intern services for miscellaneous engineering tasks. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)**

Extends for one year the agreement with University of Colorado at Denver for on-call student intern services for miscellaneous engineering tasks with a maximum annual amount not to exceed \$500,000 and a total not to exceed \$2,500,000. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 8-5-10.

**CB10-0697 A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification of 5550 E. Evans Avenue. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)**

Changes the zoning of the parcel at 5550 E. Evans from I-0 to S-CC-3 in Council District 6. PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS FOLLOWING PASSAGE ON FIRST READING. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 8-10-10.

**Neighborhood, Community & Business Revitalization**

**CB10-0648 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, acting by and through Emily Griffith Opportunity School, to provide TANF services including employment and training services. (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)**

Approves a contract between the City and County of Denver and the Emily Griffith Opportunity School in the amount of \$763,614 to provide TANF services including employment and training assistance. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

## **Public Works**

### **CB10-0615 A bill for an ordinance approving an Option to Purchase Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Forest City Enterprises, Inc. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Allows Forest City to purchase parcels being used for 56th Ave. improvements with stipulation that street improvements are to be supported and undisturbed by later development. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

### **CB10-0634 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Master Purchase Order between the City and County of Denver and Blauer Manufacturing, Incorporated, for purchase of Denver Police Uniforms. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a \$1.6 million contract with Blauer Manufacturing Company for purchase of Denver Police uniforms. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

## **Safety**

### **CB10-0577 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and The University of Colorado Denver d/b/a Addiction Research and Treatment Services (ARTS) for residential and non-residential community corrections services. (SAFETY)**

Approves a \$ 3,831,549 contract with CU Health Sciences Center Peer I/Haven for community corrections services. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

**CB10-0506 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Consolidated Divisions, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Corrects the on-call contract with Consolidated Divisions to reflect M/WBE goals of 10% rather than 18%. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-16-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0510 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between CTM, Inc. d/b/a Colorado Total Maintenance and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Corrects the on-call contract with CTM to reflect M/WBE goals of 10% rather than 18%. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-16-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0509 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Goodland Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Corrects the on-call contract with Goodland Construction to reflect M/WBE goals of 10% rather than 18%. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-16-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0508 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Richdell Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Corrects the on-call contract with Richdell Construction to reflect M/WBE goals of 10% rather than 18%. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-16-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.



**CB10-0639 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Haselden Construction, LLC and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Amends the on-call contract with Haselden Construction, LLC for the Denver Fire Department boiler replacement for a maximum task amount of \$429,948.00. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0642 A bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between Goodland Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for the Babi Yar Park Improvements Project. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Approves a \$1,142,145.43 contract with Goodland Construction for bond-financed improvements at Babi Yar Park to reduce long-term maintenance, including renovation of pathways, water features, monuments; historic bridge restoration and abutment stabilization; and berming along Havana edge and Yale streetscape edge. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0629 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Third Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Simat Helliesen & Eichner, Inc. concerning professional and technical services at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Adds \$400,000 and extends the contract with Simat Helliesen & Eichner, Inc. for five years for air service development, industry research and impact studies and mobile technology to market airport concessions and services. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0699 A bill for an Ordinance approving a proposed Public Work West Corridor Right of Way Agreement (FasTracks West Corridor) between the City and County of Denver and the Regional Transportation District ("RTD") to provide for the transfer of properties to and from the City and County of Denver to and from the RTD for value specified for the purpose of furthering the FasTracks West Corridor Project. (FASTRACKS)**

Approves an intergovernmental agreement with the Regional Transportation District to transfer certain land located within the FasTracks West Corridor to facilitate completion of the transit line with the value of the City's transferred land to be credited as part of its local match obligation. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-19-10.

**CB10-0637 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Harris Corporation for maintenance services for radios and equipment used throughout the City. (FINANCE)**

Approves a contract amendment to the Harris Corporation FX Services agreement to increase the contract \$308,000 for two years of maintenance services for radios and equipment used throughout the City through July 30, 2013 for a total contract amount of \$177,000 per year. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0513 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement with West Publishing Corporation d/b/a Thomson West, to revise on-line legal research services. (GENERAL GOVERNMENT)**

Amends the contract with West Publishing Corporation, d/b/a Thomson West, to revise the online legal research access schedule and the print material discount schedule. The monthly guarantee rate will increase by \$200 effective 05/01/2010 and this rate will increase by 2% for each succeeding one year period through 04/30/2013. The cost increases are within the current cap amount (\$650,000) of this contract, so no monetary adjustment is required. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0651 A bill for an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service. (GENERAL GOVERNMENT)**

Approves the creation of two classifications - Enterprise Resource Planning Applications Administrator I and II for the Department of Technology Services. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0507 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Landtech Contractors, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Amends the on-call contract with Landtech Contractors regarding reference to M/WBE goals and commitments. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0626 A bill for an ordinance approving a First Amendment to a Cooperative Agreement with Civic Center Conservancy with regard to vendor services in Civic Center Park. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Amends the 2006 Civic Center Conservancy Cooperative Agreement to provide the Conservancy the ability to contract and manage vending in Civic Center Park in areas designated by DPR and within guidelines established by DPR; and authorizes the Conservancy to contract for additional maintenance. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-28-10.

**CB10-0636 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed User Agreement (Extension) between the City and County of Denver and Colorado Symphony Association. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Approves a first amendment to the sublease agreement for use of Boettcher Concert Hall at the Denver Performing Arts Complex by the Colorado Symphony Orchestra for total revenue in the amount of \$1,406,467 for a lease ending date on August 31, 2015. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0635 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Master Purchase Order between the City and County of Denver and SunCor Energy USA, Incorporated, for asphalt binder oil. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a purchase from SunCor of asphalt binder oil used by the City asphalt plant in the production of hot mixed asphalt in the amount of \$3.3 million. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0643 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between Centennial Engineering, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a second amendment to the Centennial Engineering, Inc. on-call agreement to add one year with a two year option and a maximum amount per year not to exceed \$500,000 to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0644 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between URS Corporation and the City & County of Denver to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an amendment to the on-call professional services agreement with URS Corporation for a one-year term with a two year option not to exceed \$500,000 annually. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0646 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between Hartwig & Associates, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide services for traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an amendment to the professional services agreement with Hartwig & Associates, Inc. for a one-year term with a two year option not to exceed \$500,000 annually. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0647 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an amendment to the professional services agreement with Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig, Inc. for a one-year term with a two-year option not to exceed \$500,000 annually. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0657 A bill for an ordinance approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado - Department of Transportation for the State Senate Bill 8 - Traffic Control Device Maintenance Program. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with CDOT Region 6 for the State Senate Bill 8 - Traffic Control Device Maintenance program to receive and expend annual state funds in the amount of \$1,215,754.56 over five years for the annual maintenance of traffic signals, traffic signs, and pavement markings on state highways within the City and County of Denver. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.
