6 **For an ordinance relinquishing the easements, in their entirety, reserved in**  
7 **Ordinance No. 400, Series of 1983; and, established in the Permanent Non-**  
8 **Exclusive Easement, recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Book 2848,**  
9 **Page 695, and Reception No. 2020006498, respectively, located near 1390 North**  
10 **Decatur Street.**

11 **WHEREAS**, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of  
12 the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and  
13 necessity no longer requires the easements in the above-referenced Ordinance and Permanent  
14 Non-Exclusive Easement, and subject to approval by ordinance, has relinquished the same;

15 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

16 **Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation  
17 and Infrastructure in relinquishing the easements established in Ordinance No. 400, Series of 1983,  
18 and established in the Permanent Non-Exclusive Easement, recorded with the Denver Clerk &  
19 Recorder at Book 2848, Page 695, and Reception No. 2020006498, respectively, be and the same  
20 is hereby approved and that the easements in the above-referenced Ordinance and Permanent Non-  
21 Exclusive Easement are hereby relinquished.
