Scope of work: The Provider will create two, 1.0 FTE positions that will be tasked with being dispatched to schools as needed to provide support to students who are at the beginning stages of substance misuse. This support will be provided through the implementation of Teen Intervene, an evidence-based, Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) program. These staff will also provide evidence-based, classroom programs that have demonstrated effectiveness in preventing drug-misuse. These programs include: Botvin LifeSkills Training, Sources of Strength, and opioid-specific prevention education through the Not Prescribed curriculum.
