7 For an ordinance approving a proposed donation of surplus personal computers from the
8 City and County of Denver to the nonprofit entity PCs for People.

10 **WHEREAS**, the proposed donation of surplus personal computers from the City and County of
11 Denver to PCs for People, Inc. cannot be made until after approval action by the Council of the City in
12 accordance with section 2.9.3 of the Charter of the City because, under the terms of the proposed
13 donation, the City will donate personal computers as deemed available by Technology Services to PCs
14 for People, Inc., a non-profit organization, to provide personal computers to low-income families, with a
15 focus on seniors, families with school-age children, or those in need of remote health care services;

17 **WHEREAS**, the Manager of General Services has found and declared the above property to be
18 surplus; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor has duly reviewed and approved the proposed donation;


20 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

21 **Section 1.** The proposed donation by the City of personal computers as deemed available by
22 Technology Services to PCs for People, Inc., to assist in providing personal computers to low-income
23 families, with a focus on seniors, families with school-age children, or those in need of remote health
24 care services, is hereby approved.
