A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America concerning the "Women's Second Chance Act" program funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the United States of America and the City and County of Denver, for the " Women's Second Chance Act " program, which is identified as Grant Number 2013-RW-BX-0001, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 2013-1130; be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States of America to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreements shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said programs, to be expended by the Manager of Safety, are as follows:

The foregoing authorization will fund services to the City's medium and high-risk incarcerated women with co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders in the Denver County Jail through the Denver Crime Prevention and Control Commission's Women's Community Reconnection (WCR) program.

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Section 4. The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
