The contract with the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless provides funding for rehousing assistance including short-term rental assistance, deposit assistance, housing navigation, and case management services to at least 260 households and ongoing supportive services through collaborative partners.

In the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) guidance (which provides CARES Act funding), so long as funds are obligated by 12/31/21, then we have until 9/30/22 to spend the dollars down. With this technical ability, we can spend down the remainder of the CRF funding this year and other dollars would be invested as a complement to those resources under the terms of the contract.
