A BILL

For an ordinance making rescissions from the General Fund and making appropriations in the General Fund to make a cash transfer to the Affordable Housing Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the City desires to reallocate current year savings from the General Fund to the Affordable Housing Special Revenue Fund; and

WHEREAS, said funds support City Council Amendment 1645, Series of 2023, to the Mayor’s Proposed 2024 Budget, to add \$5 million to the Affordable Housing Fund in 2023 for rental assistance (to be used in 2024) through Denver’s Temporary Rent and Utility Assistance (TRUA) program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:
