**A B I L L**

**For an ordinance approving a proposed Donation and Waiver Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Christopher M. Lavery, providing for the donation of a work of art consisting of a steel and plastic sculpture and related components.**

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Donation and Waiver Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Christopher M. Lavery cannot be executed by the proper officials of the City and County of Denver until after approval action or inaction by the Council of the City in accordance with D.R.M.C. 2-257 of the City because, under the terms of the proposed Donation and Waiver Agreement, Christopher M. Lavery will donate to the City a work of art consisting of a steel and plastic sculpture and related components; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has duly reviewed the proposed Donation and Waiver Agreement;

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**
