Denver Health and Hospital Authority has provided workers and non workers compensation services for the City and County of Denver personnel located at Denver International Airport since the airport opened. In 2009, Denver Health told airport management that they would like to close the clinic but they agreed to stay open until the airport could find another provider. The contract was extended until 12/31/2010. In late 2010, the airport realized that they needed more time to develop an alternative and asked to extend the contract into 2011. At the time the contract was extended, it was not realized that the extension would increase the total contract value over \$500,000 thus requiring Council approval.
