a. Scope of Work

Beginning 2013, the City is eligible to receive a revenue based annual payment from the Winter Park Recreational Association (WPRA) per the terms of the Winter Park Lease and Operating Agreement. The first payment from WPRA has been received this year in the amount of \$889,649. This ordinance request is to appropriate \$889,649 in the Winter Park Parks and Recreation Capital Fund for the capital repair and rehabilitation of existing park and recreation facilities. The following projects will be completed with this funding:

• \$400,649 Ruby Hill Phase II Master Plan Implementation

Completion of playground renovation as well as renovation of existing park roads and parking lots.

- \$300,000 S. Platte River Parks Rehabilitation Renovation of existing S. Platte River Trail. Additional funding needed due to Colorado flooding impacting construction costs of in-river work.
- \$189,000 Playground Rehabilitation Renovation of existing playgrounds due for replacement.
