A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the General Government Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from United States of America to award funding to the City and County of Denver for the "Head Start Grant FY 2019-20" program.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services awards Head Start funds to the City and County of Denver annually; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has sent a letter of intent (LOI) to the Mayor's Office stating their intent to provide Head Start FY2019-2020 funds in the amount of \$9,612,847.00 for Denver's Great Kids Head Start Program; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 19-0014;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

The foregoing authorization will provide services (education, nutrition, health, mental health, disabilities and family services) to 1,153 eligible children. Authorization for expenditures represents 80 percent of the total award amount and will cover the period from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.

2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
