A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the Public Health and Wellness Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1284, Series of 2021, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance, authorized the 2022 spending allocation in the Public Health and Wellness Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE) has entered an agreement with Denver Human Services to expand the Wellness Winnie program by purchasing a sprinter van to provide services in communities of need; and

WHEREAS, per said agreement the vehicle purchase will be authorized out of the DDPHE Public Health and Wellness Special Revenue Fund and then journaled to the Department of Human Services (DHS) Assistance Incentive Program Fund; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle will remain an asset of DDPHE; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, this bill request authorizes the purchase of said vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Public Health and Wellness Fund, Accounting No. 14806, the Executive Director of the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
