5		referendum is numbered 399, may the clerk and recorder reuse numbers of	
6		<u>letters</u> .	
7	(7)	(7) Notwithstanding the language of subsection (6) of this section:	
8		a. If the total number of referred measures certified for the ballot in an election	
9		is greater than the remaining letters in the series, the clerk and recorder sha	
10		restart the series by designating the first referred measure for that election

12		b. If the total number of initiatives or referenda certified for the ballot in an	
13		election is greater than the remaining numerals in the series, the clerk and	
14		recorder shall restart the series by designating the first initiative or
