  - a. Scope of Work**
    - The proposed sixth amendment would allow the extension of the agreement for twelve (12) months through December 31, 2011; and, appropriate an additional \$204,500 bringing the total agreement amount to \$1,146,400.
    - Changes to the scope of work were made to accommodate the loss of a full-time psychologist at the Denver Fire Department – to include the ability to use the contractor for on-call services as directed by the DFD.
    - Scope of work continues to define services provided for the Denver Police Department and the DPD Victim Assistance Unit.
