- Contractor provides equipment and services related to high-tech audio equipment, trained acoustic specialists and acoustic analytics capable of classifying outdoor incidents as either gunfire, or other loud sounds not classified as gunfire. For those incidents classified as gunfire, contractor provides pinpoint locations of the gunfire in the service(s) area within 60 seconds.
- Contractor's solution captures and stores a precise timestamp plus GPS coordinates for each detected incident, as well as each round of a multi-round gunfire incident. This level of detail has successfully been used in investigations and courtrooms to exonerate contentious officer-involved shootings, corroborate testimony, refute false testimony, and prove the presence of multiple shooters in the absence of physical evidence and/or eyewitnesses.
