A BILL

For an ordinance approving the North Fire Station Reimbursement Agreement between the City and County of Denver, the Denver Urban Renewal Authority, and School District No.1 in the City and County of Denver for funding relating to the design and construction of a fire station in the vicinity of 50th Avenue and Central Park Boulevard in Stapleton.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed North Fire Station Reimbursement Agreement between the City and County of Denver, the Denver Urban Renewal Authority, and School District No.1 in the City and County of Denver, in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of the North Fire Station Reimbursement Agreement, available in the office and on the web page of City Council, and to be filed in office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 2017-0086 is hereby approved.

Section 2. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said project is as follows:
