**A BILL**

**For an ordinance amending the City Retail Sales Tax Article, Article II, Chapter 53 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code and the City Use Tax Article, Article III, Chapter 53 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code to exempt the purchase of water from taxation.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That subsection 53-26(20) of the Denver Revised Municipal Code is enacted to read as follows:

(20) All sales of water.

**Section 2.** That subsection 53-97(23) of the Denver Revised Municipal Code is enacted to read as follows:

(23) All purchases or sales of water.
