4 **A RESOLUTION**

5 **Laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system a parcel**
6 **of land as a public alley bounded by West 23rd Avenue, North Eliot Street, West**
7 **24th Avenue and North Decatur Street.**

8 **WHEREAS**, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of
9 the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and
10 necessity require the laying out, opening and establishing as a public alley designated as part of the
11 system of thoroughfares of the municipality that portion of real property hereinafter more particularly
12 described, and, subject to approval by resolution has laid out, opened and established the same as
13 a public alley;

14 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

15 **Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation
16 and Infrastructure in laying out, opening and establishing as part of the system of thoroughfares of
17 the municipality the following described portion of real property situate, lying and being in the City
18 and County of Denver, State of Colorado, to wit:

11 WEST LINE OF LOT 22 ALSO BEING **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

15 **BASIS OF BEARINGS:** BEARINGS ARE BASED ON THE SOUTHERLY RANGE LINE OF
16 BLOCK 23 OF C.H. WALKER'S SUBDIVISION BETWEEN THE FOUND 1.5" ALUMINUM CAP IN
17 A RANGE BOX (L.S. 37601) AT THE INTERSECTION OF ELIOT STREET AND W. 23RD
18 AVENUE AND THE FOUND 2" ALUMINUM CAP IN A RANGE BOX (L.S. 9329) AT THE
19 INTERSECTION OF DECATUR STREET AND W. 23RD AVENUE. ASSUMED TO BEAR

25 alley.
