6 **For an ordinance relinquishing an easement, in its entirety, established in the**

15 and Infrastructure in relinquishing of the easement, in its entirety, established in the Permanent  
16 Easement for Right of Way Area recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Reception No.  
17 2020066025 be and the same is hereby approved and that the easement in the above-described  
18 Permanent Easement for Right of Way Area is hereby relinquished.
