9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

10 **WHEREAS**, the proposed donation of surplus property from the City and County of Denver
11 to the Denver Rescue Mission cannot be made until after approval action by the council of the City
12 in accordance with §2-9-3(c) of the Charter of the City and the Mayor and under the terms of the
13 proposed Donation, the City will donate thirty (30) bunkbeds to Denver Rescue Mission, for use in
14 the Denver Rescue Mission shelter located at 6100 Smith Road, Denver, CO 80216; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Manager and General Services has found and declared the preceding items
16 of property to be surplus.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**

19 **Section 1.** Subject to availability, the proposed donation of thirty (30) bunkbeds to Denver Rescue
20 Mission, for the use in the Denver Rescue Mission shelter located at 1130 Park Ave. W, Denver, CO
21 80205 by the City is hereby approved.
