13	authorizes specific activities to prevent discrimination and its effects against MBEs and WBEs who			
14	have been certified by the City's Division of Small Business Opportunity in the areas of construction,			
15	reconstruction and remodeling, and professional design and construction services, expires on			
16	December 31, 2011, according to the sunset provision contained in Section 28-83(b); and			
17	WHEREAS, Article VII of Chapter 28 of the Revised Municipal Code establishing the Small			
18	Business Enterprise (SBE) program and providing for SBE outreach, assistance, and business			
19	development by the City also expires on December 31, 2011, according to the sunset provision			
20	contained in Section 28-234(b); and			
21	WHEREAS, the City has determined that the conditions originally justifying the enactment of			
22	the MBE/WBE and SBE programs, pursuant to Ordinance No. 760, Series of 2006, still exist and			
23	that it is in the best interests of the City to extend the respective sunset periods for each program fo			
24	an additional eighteen (18) months in order to complete additional studies and an administrative			
25	review of these programs and to make a determination of whether any adjustments or revisions to			
26	Division 3 of Article III or Article VII of Chapter 28 are necessary;
