6 **For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the Denver Arts**
7 **and Venues Special Revenue Fund.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the current soundboard at Boettcher Concert Hall, home of the Colorado
10 Symphony, has exceeded its useful life and no longer supports the technical requirements of the
11 venue; and

12 **WHEREAS**, said equipment will significantly improve audio quality, reliability, and
13 functionality for symphonic and other live performances and events at Boettcher Concert Hall; and

14 **WHEREAS**, this bill request authorizes the purchase of a soundboard control surface and
15 associated components;

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**

20 **Section 1.** From the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15815,
21 the Executive Director of Denver Arts and Venues, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby
22 authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
