**A resolution levying upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the year 2016 for purposes authorized by law for School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That there is hereby levied for the year 2016 upon all taxable property within School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, the taxes in mills per dollar of assessed valuation, set forth in the following tabulation, the proceeds of the several levies to be paid into the respective funds named:

**Section 2.** If any part or parts or subsection or subsections of this levying resolution shall be held to be illegal or unconstitutional, such illegality and unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining parts of this levying resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed the remaining parts or subsections of this resolution if it had known that such other part or parts or subsection or subsections thereof would be illegal or unconstitutional.
