EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the resolution is to set a public hearing on the Service Plans for the formation and establishment of three (3) Title 32 metropolitan districts: 9th Avenue Metropolitan District No. 1 (the Coordinating District); 9th Avenue Metropolitan District No. 2 and 9th Avenue Metropolitan District No. 3 (the Financing Districts).

The boundaries of the districts will eventually encompass 26 acres located on the former campus of the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center, approximately three miles southeast of Downtown Denver's Central Business district. The boundaries of the districts are generally east of Colorado Blvd, north of 8th Ave., south of 11th Ave., and west of Bellaire Street.

The **Coordinating District** is responsible for managing, implementing and coordinating the financing, acquisition, construction, completion, operation and maintenance of all public infrastructure and services within and without the Project. The **Financing Districts** will pledge all special property tax revenue generated within its boundaries in support the activities of the Coordinating District.

City Staff will be asking Council Committee to approve the resolution on consent the week of October 23rd.

There will be a presentation on the project and the financing proposal at the Finance and Services Council Committee meeting on November 18th seeking Council Committee approval on the Urban Redevelopment Plan Amendment and Cooperation Agreement along with the Service Plan for the proposed three districts. State law requires that a public hearing be conducted prior to City Council approving a service plan, with publication to commence a minimum of 20 days prior to the hearing. The public hearing for the Service Plans of the proposed 9th Avenue Metropolitan Districts #1, #2, and #3 is anticipated to be December 8th, 2014. The 9th Avenue Urban Renewal Plan Amendment Ordinance Request, Cooperation Agreement and Hearing for the 9th Avenue Urban Redevelopment Area and the use of Tax Increment Financing are on the same City Council Schedule as the proposed Metropolitan Districts Service plan schedule.
