City and County of Denver has been selected for award of \$1,000,000.00, with a term of three years, through the Environmental Protection Agency's Environmental Justice Government-to-Government Cooperative Award Program (EPA EJG2G). The selected project will fund home electrification and weatherization retrofits for households with critical needs in Denver's Globeville, Elyria Swansea, and Northeast Park Hill neighborhoods and in the City of Commerce City. The program goals include reduction of greenhouse gas emissions from income-qualified homes, improvements in indoor air quality, and reduction of exposure to pollutants for those living with chronic respiratory and health conditions. These retrofits will be paired with targeted community engagement focused on air quality and health and will engage key stakeholders at the local, state and utility level.
