WHEREAS, pursuant to the Creation Ordinance, the District Advisory Board is required to prepare, deliver, and recommend for approval by the Board of Directors a proposed annual work plan and budget (the "Work Plan and Budget") describing the major activities to be undertaken by the District for the next succeeding fiscal year, no later than September 30 of each year; and

approval of the Council, acting as the ex officio Board of Directors of the District ("Board of Directors"),

conduct and manage all affairs of the District as the authorized agent of the Board of Directors, including

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors is authorized to approve the Work Plan and Budget; and WHEREAS, the Advisory Board has prepared, reviewed and recommended to the Council for its approval a Work Plan and Budget for the 2026 Budget Year; and

WHEREAS, the eligible electors of the District have approved ballot issues authorizing the collection, retention, and spending of the property tax and other revenues in the amounts specified in the proposed budget.
