**A B I L L**

**For an ordinance authorizing the purchase of capital equipment items from the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, Parks and Recreation - Denver Mountain Parks received grant funds from Colorado-Department of Natural Resources in 2013 for the purchase of equipment to assist in the completion of necessary fire mitigation work to reduce wildfire hazards and increase public safety in our mountain parks; and

**WHEREAS**, once this grant funded work is completed, this machinery may also be used on many other planned forestry/fire mitigation projects in mountain parks; and

**WHEREAS**, this machinery will allow Denver Mountain Parks to create much healthier forests that are more resistant to both fire and insect and disease outbreaks;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From the Parks and Recreation Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15301-7011101-R3019 Denver Mountain Parks Wildfire Risk Reduction Project, the Mayor, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment items:
