A RESOLUTION

Laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system a parcel of land as Festival Street near the intersection of 35th Street and Delgany Street.

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity require the laying out, opening and establishing as a public street designated as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality that portion of real property hereinafter more particularly described, and, subject to approval by resolution has laid out, opened and established the same as a public street;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Executive Director of Public Works in laying out, opening and establishing as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality the following described portion of real property situate, lying and being in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, to wit:

A parcel of land situated in the SE ¼ of Section 22, Township 3 South, Range 68 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, more particularly described as follows:

The southeasterly 25 feet of the land described in a warranty deed recorded February 7, 2003 at reception number 2003021094;

Together with

The southeasterly 25 feet of the land described in a warranty deed recorded April 21, 2011 at reception number 2011044032, both in the records of the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver, Colorado

be and the same is hereby approved and said real property is hereby laid out and established and declared laid out, opened and established as Festival Street.

Section 2. That the real property described in Section 1 hereof shall henceforth be known as Festival Street.
